## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: PART TWO

### 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a National Rally, promoted by Rally New Zealand and will take place on Friday 2, Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 July in the Whangarei and Kaipara areas centred on Whangarei.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements and the 2010 New Zealand Rally Championship Articles.

### 3. RALLY GUIDE 2

Rally Guide 2 for the APRC event is enclosed with this acceptance of entry. Please note the following variations for NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans Competitors.

- The first Stewards Meeting is at 1530 hrs.
- Scrutineering is on Friday 2 July at VTNZ 119 Port Road Whangarei from 1030-1400hrs as detailed in the Part 1 Supplementary Regulations.
- Competitors not doing reconnaissance may complete documentation on Friday 5 June from 1000-1400 hrs at Rally Headquarters, Quayside Town Basin as detailed in the Part 1 Supplementary Regulations.
- The driver Autograph Session does not apply to non NZRC Competitors.
- There is no end of day Parc Ferme on Saturday 3 July but those competitors who are competing on Sunday 4 July may place their car in this secured area overnight on Saturday.
- The Post-Event Parc Ferme for NZRC Group 2 / Historic Competitors will open at 1700 hrs on Sunday 4 July as per the Part 1 Supplementary Regulations.
- Results will be published according to the schedule in the Part 1 Supplementary Regulations.
- Please note that NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans service will be located directly across the road from APRC service as shown in Rally Guide 2.
- The NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans service park can only be accessed after 0600 hrs on **Saturday 3 July**.
- NZRC Group 2 / Classic and Clubmans competitors should use the **YELLOW** pages in the road book to enter or exit the service park.
- NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans competitors may refuel in their service areas in addition to the marked refuel areas
- Safety Apparel is only required to meet the standards of Schedule A. Article 13.3 "Reminders" of Rally Guide 2 does not apply to NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans competitors.
- NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans competitors who provide promotional assistance to the organisers are entitled to participate in Shakedown.
- Top Half Rally Series competitors are reminded of the compulsory Finish Ramp Ceremony commencing at 1800hrs on Saturday 3 July. Competitors will be assembled at the exit of the Clubmans Service Park before traveling to the Ceremonial Finish at the Quayside Town Basin.

### 4. REJOINING FOR DAY 2

Clubmans competitors are reminded of the Article 12C of the Supplementary Regulations that provides for the ability to rejoin for Day 2 upon payment of \$300 if not already paid.

NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans competitors are reminded that **TC8E** is the starting point for Day 2.

### 5. SERVICE

NZRC Group 2 / Historic and Clubmans Competitors will not be offered Flexi Service as shown in the Itinerary. The 'A' and 'B' TC positions will be combined as per the Part 1 Supplementary Regulations.

A normal Regroup will be in operation after Service.

Details of the refuels will be published in the Road Book and are also contained in Rally Guide 2.

### 6. POST EVENT FUNCTION

Following the ceremonial finish, prize winners for the Top Half Rally Series will be honoured at a post ramp ceremony to be held on Saturday 3 July at 1930hrs at the Kingsgate Hotel, 9 Riverside Drive, Whangarei. Prize winners will be asked to make a small address and will be given additional prizes courtesy of the Kingsgate Hotel.
